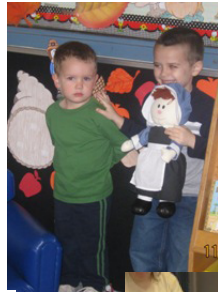




Harvest Feast

The children at EOC Tech, Child Development Center, participated in preparing and then eating their Harvest Feast, Monday, November 23, 2009. All age groups participated in preparing the food while discussing the cultures of both Native Americans and Pilgrims. Each class was responsible for certain foods and duties. We believe that in this way children will be introduced to the traits of cooperating and sharing which were truly the foundations of the first Thanksgiving celebration. We did strive to emphasize the uniqueness and differences in the various Native American cultures in a way that is appropriate for young children.

Children prepared a pop corn mix which contained various cereals, crackers, and raisins. One class also prepared fruit salad while another class filled pieces of celery with pimento cheese. Children decorated place mats, table runners, and other items to decorate their tables. They came to the table wearing medallions and other pieces of costume with instructions to remember how each of the classes helped and contributed to the feast.
